AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 24, OF THE HAWAI'I COUNTY CODE 1983 (1995 EDITION), RELATING TO VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC (Nanawale Estates Subdivision {County Owned and Private Streets} – Proposed Traffic Regulation)
