(Bill 69) AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 24, OF THE HAWAI'I COUNTY CODE 1983 (1995 EDITION), RELATING TO VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC (Authorizes a bus stop along Route 11 by Yano Hall and the Manago Hotel)
From Deputy Director Galen Kuba, Department of Public Works, dated May 15, 2001, transmitting the above bill. Authorizing a bus stop at this location will provide a safe area for riders to wait for and board the County bus.
