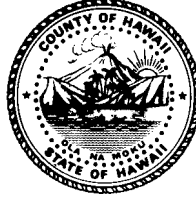

This measure (1) specifies and clarifies the responsibilities of the protocol officer in the process for terminating a sister city relationship and (2) clears up inconsistencies between Section 2-165(c) and Section 2-166(c) of the Hawai'i County Code.

Recommends passage of Bill 118, as amended (Draft 2), on first reading.
