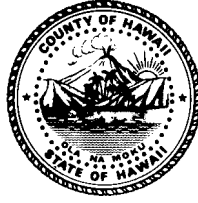

Comm. 330: AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 24, OF THE HAWAI‘I COUNTY CODE 1983 (1995 EDITION), RELATING TO VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC (Kilauea Avenue at Waiakeawaena Elementary School proposals: to add a new bus stop; eliminate the existing Mid-Block Crosswalk fronting the Administration Office at Waiakeawaena Elementary School to accommodate the new proposed bus stop and to adjust passenger loading zone)

From Bruce C. McClure, Director of Public Works, dated August 22, 2003, transmitting the above bill which was a result of a request from the Waiakeawaena School’s Safety Committee, with the concurrence of the Waiakeawaena Parents Teachers Association, the Waiakeawaena School Community Based Management Committee, parents, students and staff.

The existing crossing guard at the existing Mid-Block Crosswalk will be relocated to the Kilauea Avenue-Kawailani Street intersection.

Comm. 331: AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 24, OF THE HAWAI'I COUNTY CODE 1983 (1995 EDITION) RELATING TO VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC (establishing a public taxi stand at the pier in Kailua-Kona)
 From Tom Brown, Transit Administrator, dated August 13, 2003, transmitting the above ordinance bill. States, currently, taxis greeting visiting cruise ships have no staging area in which to wait for potential riders. The taxi stand, which will be located just outside the guard shack at the entrance to the pier, will provide two stalls for taxis.
