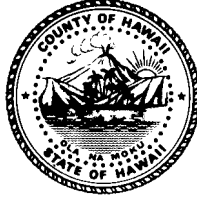

Comm. 436:
 (Bill 151) AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 20, OF THE HAWAI'I COUNTY CODE 1983 (2005 EDITION) RELATING TO LITTERING AND REFUSE DISPOSAL (adds that each day of violation for littering shall constitute a separate offense; and imposes a penalty of not less than \$250 and not more than \$1,000 for illegal dumping, and each day of violation shall constitute a separate offense.)
 From Councilmember Bob Jacobson, dated August 31, 2005, transmitting the above bill, which seeks to strengthen enforcement of illegal dumping by facilitating realistic enforcement.
