(Bill 54) AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 24, OF THE HAWAI'I COUNTY CODE 1983 (1995 EDITION), RELATING TO VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC (starts a new 90-day period for four temporary loading zones along Ali'i Drive)
From Public Works Director Bruce C. McClure, P.E., dated March 3, 2005, transmitting the above bill. The Department of Public Works authorized four (4) temporary loading zones along Ali'i Drive on December 21, 2004 to address the lack of loading zones within Kailua Village. These were done under the 90-day authority of the Hawai'i County Code, Section 24-11, and this authority ends on March 18, 2005. The loading zones were monitored and were favorably accepted by the Kailua Village Merchants Association and six delivery services. Field changes are being made to add permanent "No Parking" signs and will be starting a new 90-day period, which will end on June 15, 2005.
