Presentation on Termites by Dr. Julian Yates, Plant and Environmental Protection Specialist at the University of Hawai'i at Manoa (Comm. 187.4)

REFERRALS

- Comm. 223: AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 24 OF THE HAWAI'I COUNTY CODE
(Bill 84) 1983 (1995 EDITION) RELATING TO VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC (one-way streets - Sarona Road; prohibited left turn areas - Kuakini Highway at Sarona Road, Kailua-Kona)
- From Public Works Director Bruce C. McClure, P.E., dated April 14, 2005, transmitting the above bill. As part of the Kuakini Highway Improvement project, the Department of Public Works, Engineering Division, will convert a portion of Sarona Road from one-way to two-way traffic, and prohibit left turns at Kuakini Highway. This change is necessary because a driveway serving Kuakini Towers will be removed.
- Recommends passage of Bill 84 on first reading.**
- Comm. 225: A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ACQUISITION OF PRIVATE PROPERTY
(Res. 83-05) BY EMINENT DOMAIN, BEING LOT R-1, TAX MAP KEY: (3)7-3-010:029, AND ROAD LOT A, TAX MAP KEY: (3)7-3-010:036 (PORTION), SITUATE AT KALAOA, NORTH KONA, COUNTY AND STATE OF HAWAI'I, FOR THE DEVELOPMENT AND CONSTRUCTION OF A CONNECTOR ROAD BETWEEN KAUAHALE STREET AND AHIAHI STREET, KONA, HAWAI'I; and
- Recommends adoption of Res. 83-05.**

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

- Comm. 187:
(Bill 71) AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 5, ARTICLE 1 OF THE HAWAI'I COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO BUILDING
-
- From Public Works Director Bruce C. McClure, P.E., dated March 21, 2005, transmitting the above bill. The County of Hawai'i is currently using the 1991 Edition of the Uniform Building Code, adopted on November 8, 1993. However, certain sections in the code do not apply to local construction conditions or situations. As part of the adoption process, the County of Hawai'i has presented revisions to the Building Code amendments to the community at four meetings, two in Hilo and two in Kona.

The purpose of this bill is to repeal Chapter 5, Article 1, Building Code, in its entirety by adopting amendments to address local conditions and situations. Significant changes to the amendments are: building permit fees have been reduced for buildings under 1,400 square feet, while for buildings larger than this, the fees remain the same; a building permit will not be required for one detached single-story non-residential use type building per property, and the building cannot exceed 120 square feet of floor area and must have a height, when measured from the ground, of 12'-0" or less; Package Model Homes may be pre-approved by the Department of Public Works, Building Division; increase the valuation of work from \$1,000 to \$4,000 that would require a building permit; and reduce retaining wall height from 6'-0" to 4'-0" that would require a building permit and an engineer's stamp.

(Draft 2) From Public Works Director Bruce C. McClure, P.E., dated April 1, 2005, transmitting Draft 2 of Bill 71. Draft 2 includes figures and maps to Amendment 5-1.0.126 that were missing in Draft 1, and edits subscripts and equations in Amendment 5-1.0.127 for improved legibility.

McClure, P.E., dated April 13, 2005, informing the Council that Dr. Julian Yates, Specialist for the Plant and Environmental Protection Sciences at the University of Hawai'i at Manoa, has agreed to provide a 20 to 30 minute informational PowerPoint presentation on termites, as several members of the public spoke against the mandatory treatment for ground termites required by the Building Code at a previous meeting of the Committee.
