Pursuant to §92-41, Hawai'i Revised Statutes, notice is hereby given that the Hawai'i County Council will be holding public hearings to hear testimony on:

Bill 300: Amends Chapter 14 of the Hawai'i County Code 1983 (2005 Edition), as Amended, General Welfare. {Policy objectives are: 1) no alcohol in any County parks and recreation facility without a permit; 2) permit for alcohol only at a limited number of narrowly defined sites; and 3) permit for alcohol only during one time period (12 p.m. to 10 p.m.).}

All interested persons are invited to attend and they shall be afforded the opportunity to be heard. Those persons wishing to testify in person must register with the Council/Clerk's staff prior to the convening of the hearing. Those testifying in person and submitting written testimony should bring 16 copies of the testimony for distribution at the meeting.
