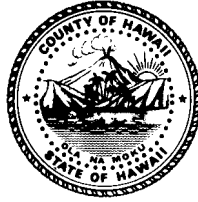

From Mayor Harry Kim, dated February 5, 2007, requesting the confirmation of the following individuals to the Hawai'i County Liquor Commission:

*Mr. Everette L. Souza of Council District 1 is a 59-year resident of Hawai'i. He is self-employed as the owner of Mister Fixit after working for HELCO for 33 years as a foreman and retiring in 2003. He states that he is affiliated with the Democratic party. If confirmed, he will serve a term to expire on December 31, 2009, replacing Mr. Takashi Domingo, who resigned.*

*Ms. Ioana D. Agasa of Council District 4 is a 50-year resident of Hawai'i. She is a self-employed CPA and a member of the Rotary Club of South Hilo. She states that she is not affiliated with any political party, and, if confirmed, will serve a term to expire on December 31, 2011.*

She is the Athletic Director at Keaau High School and the coordinator of the Drug, Alcohol and Tobacco and the Shattered Dreams Programs. She states that she is not affiliated with any political party, and, if confirmed, will serve a term to expire on December 31, 2011.*

A lobbyist means "any individual engaged for pay or other consideration who spends more than five hours in any month or \$275 in any six-month period for the purpose of attempting to influence legislative or administrative action by communicating or urging others to communicate with public officials." {Article 15, Section 2-91.3(a)(6), Hawai'i County Code}.
