NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that in compliance with Chapter 19, Article 11, Section 19-90(b) of the Hawai'i County Code, as amended, the County Council of the County of Hawai'i has scheduled the Real Property Tax Rate Resolution on its agenda on the following date, time and place for the purpose of fixing the real property tax rates for the fiscal year July 1, 2007 to June 30, 2008.

The real property tax rates for the fiscal year July 1, 2007 to June 30, 2008, shall be fixed as follows:

These rates would be fixed by the County Council upon its adoption of Resolution No. 184-07. If the Council does not act upon Resolution No. 184-07 on or before June 20, 2007, the tax rates as previously set shall be applicable to fiscal year 2007-2008.

All interested persons are invited to attend, and they shall be afforded the opportunity to be heard. Those desiring to address the County Council should register prior to the convening of the meeting.
