

HAWAI‘I COUNTY COUNCIL'S NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARINGS

Pursuant to §92-41, Hawai‘i Revised Statutes (hereinafter “HRS”), notice is hereby given that public hearings will be held by the Council of the County of Hawai‘i for the purpose of considering Bill 285, Draft 2:

Authorizes the Issuance of General Obligation Bonds of the County of Hawai‘i for the Purpose of Funding All or a Portion of the Costs of Various Improvement Projects for the County; Fixing the Form, Denominations, and Certain Other Details of Such Bonds and Providing for the Sale Thereof; and Authorizes the Taking of Other Actions Relating to the Issuance and Sale of the Bonds. The principal amount not to exceed \$114,588,700, these funds would be used for a variety of capital improvement projects. Prioritization of projects is based on the following: addresses legal mandates, corrects major deficiencies or items critical for public safety and health, and addresses environmental concerns, operational efficiency and maintenance or improvement of existing assets.
