I. 2001 County Reapportionment Plan

The number of Council persons to be elected from each district will be one.
The Council districts are described as follows:

COUNCIL DISTRICTS

DISTRICT I – That portion of the Island of Hawaii for convenience herein referred to as the Hamakua District, North Hilo District and portion of South Hilo, more particularly described as follows: Beginning at the intersection of the shoreline and North Kohala – Hamakua District boundary at Honokea Stream and running: (1) southerly along said boundary to the South Kohala District boundary; (2) southeasterly on said boundary to the Kohala Forest Reserve boundary; (3) generally southeasterly along said boundary to the South Kohala – Hamakua District boundary; (4) southeasterly along said boundary to the Watershed boundary; (5) westerly along said boundary to the unimproved road at the Waimea Reservoir; (6) southerly on said road to White Road; (7) southerly along said road to Mana Road; (8) westerly then southeasterly along said road to the South Kohala-Hamakua district boundary; (9) generally southwesterly along said boundary to the Auwaiakeakua Gulch; (10) southeasterly along said gulch to a 4 WD drive road; (11) generally southeasterly along said road to the Military Reservation and Game Management Area boundary; (12) southeasterly, then southwesterly to the Saddle Road; (13) southeasterly along said road to the Military Reservation and Game Management Area boundary; (14) generally southeasterly along said boundary to the Hamakua-North Hilo district boundary; (15) southwesterly along said boundary to the Saddle Road; (16) easterly along said road to the North Hilo-South Hilo district boundary; (17) northeasterly along said boundary to the Awehi Stream; (18) southeasterly along said stream to the Waiiau Stream; (19) southeasterly along said stream to Tiger2000 line 202998321; (20) northerly along said line to Puueo Mauka Road; (21) northeasterly, then northwesterly along said road to Tiger2000 line 202998203 at the Pukihae Stream; (22) easterly along said line to Aikane Road; (23) northerly along said road to the Pohakunanaka Stream; (24) southeasterly along said stream to Wainaku Avenue; (25) northerly along said avenue to an unnamed stream; (26) easterly along said stream to its intersection with the shoreline at Alealea Point; (27) northwesterly along said shoreline to the point of beginning.

DISTRICT 2 – That portion of the Island of Hawaii for convenience herein referred to as a portion of South Hilo more particularly described as follows: Beginning at the intersection of the shoreline and an unnamed stream at Alealea Point and running (1) westerly along said stream to Wainaku Avenue; (2) southerly along said avenue to the Pohakunanaka Stream; (3) northwesterly along said stream to Aikane Road; (4) southerly along said road to TIGER2000 line 202998203; (5) westerly along said line to Puueo Mauka Road at the Pukihae Stream; (6) southeasterly, then southwestly along said road to TIGER2000 line 202998321; (7) southwestly along said line to the Waiiau Stream; (8) northwesterly along said stream to the Awehi Stream; (9) westerly, then northwesterly along said river to the North Hilo–South Hilo District Boundary; (10) southwestly, then southeasterly along said boundary to the intersection of the Saddle Road and the South Hilo – North Hilo District Boundary; (11) continuing southeasterly along said boundary to the South Hilo–Kau District Boundary; (12) northerly along unnamed boundary to Tiger2000 Line 203040109 at the Waiakea Forest Reserve Boundary; (13) northeasterly along said boundary to Tiger2000 Line 203040112 at the Waiakea Forest Reserve Boundary; (14) northeasterly along said boundary to a straight line extension of Haihai Street; (15) easterly along said extension to the Waiakea Stream; (16) northeasterly along said stream to Kupulau Road (17) northerly along said road to West Kawaiiani Street; (18) easterly along said street to Komohana Street; (19) northerly along said street to the Waiakea Stream; (20) northeasterly along said stream to West Lanikaula Street; (21) easterly along said street to Kinoole Street; (22) northerly along said street to Mohouli Street; (23) westerly along said street to Kapiolani Street; (24) northerly along said street to Haili Street; (25) easterly along said street to Kinoole Street; (26) northerly along said street to Waianuenue Avenue; (27) easterly along said avenue to Hilo Bayfront Highway; (28) northerly along said highway to its intersection with the shoreline at Mokupane Point; (29) northwesterly along said shoreline to the point of beginning.

DISTRICT 3 – That portion of the Island of Hawaii for convenience herein referred to as a portion of South Hilo and a portion of Puna more particularly described as follows: Beginning at the intersection of the shoreline and South Hilo – Puna District Boundary at Paukupahu and running (1) southwesterly along said boundary to State Highway 11; (2) northwesterly along said highway to Kilauea Avenue; (3) northwesterly along said avenue to Haihai Street; (4) westerly along said street to Iwalani Street; (5) northerly along said street to West Kawaihine Street; (6) westerly along said street to Kupulau Road; (7) southerly along said road to Waiakea Stream; (8) southwesterly along said stream to a straight line extension of Haihai Street; (9) westerly along said straight line extension to the Waiakea Forest Reserve Boundary; (10) southwesterly along said boundary to Tiger2000 Line 203040112 at the Waiakea Forest Reserve Boundary ; (11) southwesterly along said boundary to Tiger2000 Line 203040109 at the Waiakea Forest Reserve Boundary to an unnamed boundary; (12) southerly along said unnamed boundary to the South Hilo – Kau District Boundary; (13) southeasterly along said boundary to the South Hilo – Puna District Boundary, (14) northeasterly along said boundary to TIGER2000 line 203012707; (15) southeasterly along said line to a 4WD road; (16) southwesterly, southerly, then easterly along said road to Mokihana Farm Lots Road; (17) southeasterly along said road to Ihope Road; (18) northeasterly along said road to Peck Road; (19) southeasterly along said road to State Highway 11; (20) northeasterly along said highway to South Kulani Road; (21) southeasterly along said road to the Grant Boundary; (22) northeasterly along said boundary to Road A; (23) northeasterly along said road to Road 11; (24) southeasterly along said road to Road D; (25) westerly along said road to Road 9; (26) southeasterly along said road to Ainaloa Boulevard; (27) northeasterly along said boulevard to State Highway 130; (28) northwesterly along said highway to Shower Drive; (29) northeasterly along said drive to Hawaiian Paradise Park Subdivision Boundary; (30) northeasterly along said boundary to its intersection with the shoreline at Kaloli Point; (31) northwesterly, then northeasterly along said shoreline to the point of beginning.

DISTRICT 4 – That portion of the Island of Hawaii for convenience herein referred to as a portion of South Hilo more particularly described as follows: Beginning at the intersection of the shoreline and Bayfront Highway at Mokupane Point and running (1) southerly along said highway to Waianuenue Ave; (2) westerly along said avenue to Kapiolani Street; (3) southerly along said street to Mohouli Street; (4) easterly along said street to Kinoole Street; (5) southerly along said street to West Lanikaula Street; (6) westerly along said street to the Waiakea Stream; (7) southwesterly along said stream to Komohana Street; (8) southerly along said street to West Kawailani Street; (9) easterly along said street to Iwalani Street; (10) southerly along said street to Haihai Street; (11) easterly along said street to Kilauea Avenue; (12) southeasterly along said avenue to State Highway 11; (13) southeasterly along said highway to the South Hilo – Puna District Boundary; (14) northeasterly along said boundary to its intersection with the shoreline at Paukupu; (15) northwesterly, then westerly along said shoreline to the point of beginning.

DISTRICT 5 – That portion of the Island of Hawaii for convenience herein referred to as Puna and more particularly described as follows: Beginning at the intersection of the shoreline at Kaloli Point and the Hawaiian Paradise Park Subdivision boundary and running (1) westerly along said subdivision boundary to Shower Drive; (2) southwesterly along said drive to State Highway 130; (3) southerly along said highway to Ainaloa Boulevard; (4) westerly along said boulevard to Road 9 (Hawaiian Acres); (5) southeasterly along said road to the Waikahekahe Iki Boundary; (6) southwesterly along said boundary to Crater Rim Drive; (7) southwesterly along said drive to Chain of Craters Road; (8) southeasterly, then northeasterly along said road to Hawaii Volcanoes National Park Boundary; (9) southeasterly along said boundary to its intersection with the shoreline at Kupapau Point; (10) northeasterly then northwesterly along said shoreline to the point of beginning.

DISTRICT 6 – That portion of the Island of Hawaii for convenience herein referred to as Kau and portions of South Kona and Puna more particularly described as follows: Beginning at the intersection of the shoreline at Kupapau Point and Hawaii Volcanoes National Park Boundary and running (1) northwesterly along said boundary to the Chain of Craters Road; (2) southwesterly, then northwesterly along said road to Crater Rim Drive; (3) northeasterly along said drive to Waikahekahe Iki Boundary; (4) northeasterly along said boundary to Road 9 (Hawaiian Acres); (5) northwesterly along said road to Road D; (6) easterly along said road to Road 11; (7) northwesterly along said road to Road A; (8) southwesterly along said road to the Grant Boundary; (9) southwesterly along said boundary to South Kulani Road; (10) northwesterly along said road to State Highway 11; (11) southwesterly along said highway to Peck Road; (12) northwesterly along said road to Ihope Road; (13) southwesterly along said road to Mokihana Farm Lots Road; (14) northwesterly along said road to a 4WD road; (15) southwesterly, northwesterly, then northeasterly along said road to TIGER2000 Line 203012707; (16) southwesterly along said line to South Hilo–Puna District Boundary; (17) southwesterly along said boundary to South Hilo–Kau District Boundary; (18) northwesterly along said boundary to the Puu Oo Volcano Trail; (20) southerly along said trail to a 4WD road; (21) southerly along said road to the Hawaii Volcanoes National Park Boundary; (22) northwesterly along said boundary to the intersection of the North Hilo – Kau District Boundary and the Forest Reserve Boundary; (23) continuing northwesterly, then southwesterly along the Hawaii Volcanoes National Park Boundary to the intersection of the Hamakua – Kau District Boundary; (24) continuing northwesterly; then southwesterly along the Hawaii Volcanoes National Park Boundary to the North Kona – Kau District Boundary; (25) southwesterly along said boundary to a 4WD road; (26) northwesterly, then southwesterly along said road to Telephone Exchange Road; (27) westerly along said road to State Highway 11; (28) northerly along said highway to Old Government Main Road (Kalamakapala); (29) northwesterly, then southerly along said road to TIGER2000 Line 203043214; (30) southwesterly along said line to Upper Napoopoo Road; (31) southerly along said road to Lower Napoopoo Road; (32) northwesterly along said road to Pu’uhonua Road; (33) northwesterly along said road and continuing along a straight line extension of said road to its intersection with the shoreline at Kealakekua Bay; (34) generally southeasterly, then northeasterly along said shoreline to the point of beginning.

DISTRICT 7 – That portion of the island of Hawaii for convenience herein referred to as portions of South Kona and North Kona more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the shoreline and a straight line extension to Pu'uhonua Road at Kealakekua Bay running (1) southeasterly along said road to Lower Napoopoo Road; (2) southeasterly along said road to Upper Napoopoo Road; (3) northerly along said road to Tiger2000 line 203043214; (4) easterly along said line to Old Government Main Road (Kalamakapala); (5) northerly, then southeasterly along said road to State Highway 11; (6) southerly along said highway to Telephone Exchange Road; (7) easterly along said road to a 4 WD road; (8) generally northeasterly, then southeasterly along said road to the North Kona-Kau District Boundary; (9) northeasterly along said boundary to the intersection of the Hawaii Volcanoes National Park Boundary; (10) northeasterly, then southeasterly along said boundary to the Hamakua – Kau District Boundary; (11) continuing northeasterly, then southeasterly along the Hawaii Volcanoes National Park Boundary to the intersection of the North Hilo – Kau District Boundary and the Forest Reserve Boundary; (12) continuing southeasterly along the Hawaii Volcanoes National Park Boundary to a 4 WD road; (13) northerly along said road to the Puu Oo Volcano Trail; (14) northwesterly along said trail to South Hilo–North Hilo District Boundary; (15) northwesterly along said boundary to Saddle Road; (16) westerly along said road to the Hamakua – North Hilo District Boundary; (17) southerly along said boundary to the Military Reservation Boundary; (18) southeasterly, westerly, northwesterly, southwesterly, westerly, then southerly along said boundary to the boundary bordering Pohakuloa Training Area, then west on said boundary to the Hamakua–North Kona District Boundary; (19) northwesterly along said boundary to Forest Reserve Boundary at Naohuelelua; (20) northwesterly along said boundary to a 4 WD road; (21) southwestly along said road to Judd Trail; (22) southwestly along said trail to a 4 WD road; (23) northwesterly along said road to Waiaha Stream; (24) southwestly along said stream to Hienaloli Road; (25) northerly along said road to Nani Kailua Drive; (26) westerly along said drive to Hoene Street; (27) southerly, then westerly along said street to Welo Street; (28) northerly along said street to Nani Kailua Drive; (29) westerly along said drive to State Highway 11; (30) southeasterly along said highway to Kuakini Highway; (31) northwesterly along said highway to Walua Road; (32) northwesterly along said road to Lunapule Road; (33) westerly along said road and continuing along a straight line extension of said road to its intersection with the shoreline; (34) southeasterly along said shoreline to the point of beginning.

DISTRICT 8 – That portion of the Island of Hawaii for convenience herein referred to as North Kona more particularly described as follows: Beginning at the intersection of the shoreline and a straight line extension to Lunapule Road and running (1) easterly along said road to Walua Road; (2) southeasterly along said road to Kuakini Highway; (3) southeasterly along said highway to State Highway 11; (4) northwesterly along said highway to Nani Kailua Drive; (5) easterly along said drive to Welo Road; (6) southerly along said road to Hoene Street; (7) easterly, then northwesterly along said road to Nani Kailua Drive; (8) easterly along said drive to Hienaloli Road; (9) southeasterly along said road to Waiaha Stream; (10) northeasterly along said stream to a 4 WD road; (11) southeasterly along said road to Judd Trail; (12) northeasterly along said trail to a 4 WD road; (13) northeasterly, then southeasterly along said road to the Forest Reserve Boundary at Naohueleelua; (14) southeasterly along said boundary to the Hamakua–North Kona District Boundary; (15) southeasterly along said boundary to the Military Reservation Boundary; (16) easterly, then northerly to the boundary bordering Pohakuloa Training Area; (17) easterly, northeasterly, southeasterly, then easterly along said boundary to the Military Reservation Boundary; (18) northwesterly along said boundary to the Hamakua – North Hilo District Boundary; (19) northerly, then northeasterly along said boundary to the Military and Game Management Area Boundary; (20) northwesterly, southwesterly, then northwesterly along said boundary to the Saddle Road; (21) northwesterly along said road to the Military Reservation and Game Management Area Boundary; (22) northeasterly, then northwesterly along said boundary to a 4 WD road; (23) northwesterly along said road to the Auwaiakeakua Gulch; (24) northwesterly along said gulch to the South Kohala–Hamakua District boundary; (25) southwesterly, then southerly along said boundary to a 4 WD road at Puu Keekee; (26) northwesterly along said road to State Highway 190; (27) southwesterly along said highway to a 4 WD road; (28) northwesterly along said road to the Lava Flow of 1859; (29) southwesterly along said lava flow to its intersection with the shoreline at Pueo Bay; (30) southwesterly, then southeasterly along said shoreline to the point of beginning.

DISTRICT 9 – That portion of the Island of Hawaii for Convenience herein referred to as North and South Kohala and portion of North Kona more particularly described as follows: Beginning at the intersection of the shoreline and the Lava Flow of 1859 at Pueo Bay and running (1) northeasterly along said lava flow to a 4 WD road; (2) southeasterly along said road to State Highway 190; (3) northeasterly along said highway to a 4 WD road; (4) southeasterly, northeasterly, then southeasterly along said road to the South Kohala–Hamakua District Boundary at Puu KeeKee; (5) northerly, then northeasterly along said boundary to the Auwaiakeakua Gulch; (6) northwesterly along said gulch to the South Kohala–Hamakua District Boundary; (7) northeasterly, then northerly along said boundary to Mana Road; (8) northwesterly, then easterly along said road to White Road; (9) northerly along said road to an unimproved road at the Waimea Reservoir; (10) northerly along said road to the Watershed Boundary; (11) northeasterly along said boundary to the South Kohala–Hamakua District Boundary; (12) northwesterly along said boundary to the Kohala Forest Reserve Boundary; (13) generally northwesterly along said boundary to the South Kohala District Boundary; (14) northwesterly along said boundary to the North Kohala-Hamakua District Boundary; (15) generally northwesterly along said boundary to the Honokea Stream; (16) northerly along said boundary to its intersection of the shoreline; (17) northwesterly, southeasterly then southwesterly along shoreline to the point of beginning.
