Automotive fluids, antifreeze, used motor oil, corrosives, all types of batteries, fluorescent lights & ballasts, mercury thermometers, unused or outdated prescription medications (no controlled substances or sharps & needles), compressed gas cylinders, oil-based paint & stains, toxic garden supplies, poisons & miscellaneous toxic household products

WHAT'S NOT ACCEPTED:

Business or farm waste, latex paint and base, explosives, pyrophorics, flares & water reactive materials, biological or infectious waste, radioactive & shock sensitive materials, fire extinguishers, detergents, & non-hazardous materials
