Authority: Hawaii County Charter, Section 4-4, in accordance with Hawaii Revised Statutes, Section 349-9, as amended, and the Older Americans Act of 1965.

Appointment: Mayor, no confirmation required. Members are co-terminous with the Mayor.

Full Membership: No specific number.

Specific Representation: At least one-half of the members must be age 60 or older. Representatives of elected officials and senior citizen groups or agencies must be included.

Requirements: None specified.

Meetings: Normally, one meeting per quarter.

Financial Disclosure: Not required.

Reappointment: Per Mayor's discretion.

Qualities: Respected by the community as being community-minded and oriented. Able to focus on the community needs as a whole without catering to special or self-interest.
