

HAWAII COUNTY BICYCLE/PEDESTRIAN ADVISORY COMMITTEE

3/16/06

Purpose: To advise the Mayor in the encouragement and facilitation of the use of bicycling and walking as a regular means of transportation and recreation, in conformance to the 1979 Big Island Bikeway Plan and the State of Hawaii Bike Plan when it is enacted.

To secure federal grant monies available from the International Surface Transportation Efficiency Act (ISTEA).

Authority: Hawaii County Charter, Section 4-4.

Appointment: Mayor, no confirmation required. Members are co-terminous with the Mayor.

Full Membership: No restrictions. However, it is suggested that the committee have at least one member from each of the nine council districts when possible. It may include ex-officio members from the Parks, Public Works and Planning Departments.

Requirements: Annual report to the Mayor required. Due within 90 days of close of fiscal year.

Meetings: Bi-Monthly meetings.

Financial Disclosure: Not required.

Qualities: Respected by the community as being community-minded and oriented. Able to focus on the community needs as a whole without catering to special or self-interest.
