

**HIGHWAY SAFETY COUNCIL**

Purpose: To advise the Mayor on matters relating to highway safety.

Authority: Hawaii Revised Statutes, Section 286-6.

Appointment: Mayor, no confirmation required. Members are co-terminous with the Mayor.

Full Membership: The following or their designated representatives: the Mayor, Chief of Police, Prosecuting Attorney, Corporation Counsel, Traffic Engineer, Chairman of Traffic Commission or Safety Program Coordinator, and not more than 15 others.

Specific Representation: None required.

Requirements: Members must have an interest in highway safety and a knowledge of local conditions.

Meetings: No specific requirement.

Financial Disclosure: Not required.

Reappointment: Per Mayor's discretion.

Qualities: Respected by the community as being community-minded and oriented. Able to focus on the community needs as a whole without catering to special or self-interest.
