

LIQUOR CONTROL ADJUDICATION BOARD

04/05/07

Purpose: To hear and determine complaints regarding violations of State liquor laws or violations of Liquor Commission rules and regulations and to impose fines or penalties as provided by law.

Authority: Hawaii County Charter, Section 7-3.3.

Appointment: Mayor with Council approval. Normal five year staggered terms.

Full Membership: Five members.

Specific Representation: None required.

Requirements: No more than three shall belong officially to same political party.

Meetings: Normally every other month on Thursday if workload requires, beginning at 9:30 a.m., at Liquor Control conference room, Hilo or Kona.

Financial Disclosure: Members must file Financial Disclosure within 20 working days of taking the oath of office. Thereafter, annual disclosures must be filed on or before January 31. The disclosures are confidential and will be kept on file by the Board of Ethics. County Code, Chapter 2, Section 2-91.1.

Reappointment: Following the expiration of a term, no member may be reappointed for at least two years.

Qualities: Respected by the community as being community-minded and oriented. Able to focus on the community needs as a whole without catering to special or self-interest.
