PETITIONERS: JAN R. HERRON-WHITEHEAD AND LAVERNE TILL (BOA 07-000048) - Appeal of Final Subdivision Approval (SUB 04-000221) granted by the Planning Director dated May 8, 2007, for Luiala'i at Parker Ranch Phase 3. The subject project area is located to the southwest of the Waimea Shopping Center, Waikoloa and Pu'ukapu, South Kohala, Hawai'i, TMK: (3) 6-7-2:57, 58 & 60.
