NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Pursuant to Chapter 54, Part III, and 91-3 of the Hawai'i Revised Statutes, notice is hereby given that the Water Board of the County of Hawai'i will hold a public hearing on a proposed rule to be added to the Department of Water Supply's Rules and Regulations. The topic of the proposed rule is the acceptance of existing private water systems. The proposed rule lists situations in which the Water Board will not accept existing private water systems as well as listing all of the requirements that must be met in order for the Water Board to accept private water systems.

Copies of the proposed rule, which would be added as Section 4-13, is available for review at the Department of Water Supply's main office during normal work hours. A copy of the proposed rule will be mailed to any interested person who requests a copy and pays the required fees for the copy and postage.
